SXM AIRPORT KICKS OFF MEETINGS WITH HUB PARTNERS OF ANGUILLA

Simpson Bay, St. Maarten - The Management Team of the Princess Juliana International Airport (SXM) kicked off a series of meetings it will be holding with the hub partners during the first quarter of the new year with an extensive exchange of information with the Anguillan authorities.

"The importance of meeting with the hub partners cannot be over-emphasized," said Michel Hyman, COO of SXM Airport. "It is quite essential for the continued working relationship between the Princes Juliana International Airport and all its hub partners," adding that "partnership" depends on timely and effective communication.

And according to Donna Banks, Chairperson of the Anguilla Tourist Board, who led the Anguilla delegation, "The long-term goals of a budding relationship was the core premise of the discussions."

Chairperson Donna Banks recalled the days when the hub partners came together to jointly seek new airline services and expressed the wish to see this happen once again.

Simpson Bay, St. Maarten — The Princess Juliana International Airport (SXM) will soon erect two big, air-conditioned tents that is intended to better accommodate the passengers and other users of the facility temporarily, until the Terminal Building can be restored to its pre-Hurricane Irma state.

"The tents will enhance customer comfort and upgrade the current operations both for the Arrival and Departure areas, thus freeing up the General Aviation (FBO building) that is now being used for arriving passengers," Hyman, COO of SXM Airport, said. The tent will also be customized to include offices and bathroom facilities.
